The Alleghany CARES Medication Assistance Program provides cost-free medications for qualified residents of Alleghany County.

### LOCATION

25 Womble Street, Burgundy canopy “OFFICE”

### SCHEDULE

CARES office is open Monday – Friday 8AM- 5PM. See the Executive Director

### Documentation Needed for Eligibility

#### 1) Proof of Alleghany County Residency

Valid NC Drivers License  
**AND**  
 Current utility bill with name and address:  
 -Home telephone bill  
 -Electricity/heating oil other utility bill

#### 2) Proof of Income for the Household

| If you are:                        | Document(s) Needed:   |

| Self-employed                      | Schedule C, IRS Tax Form 1040<br>-if adjusted gross income is negative (self-employment lost money), then Support Letter is required – see below  |
| Employed                           | Paycheck stubs/receipt: one month’s worth of stubs from the last 60 days (must be dated within the past 60 days):<br><div style="margin-left: 40px;">           -if paid weekly, 4 stubs<br/>           -if paid biweekly, 2 stubs<br/>           -if paid monthly, 1 stub         </div>   |
| Receiving Social Security Benefits | Current year social security benefit letter<br>(can get print out from social security office)  |
| On Social Security Disability      | Original award letter, with start date<br>Current year social security benefit letter (can get print out from social security office)   |
| Unemployed/No Income               | Most recent IRS tax return (if no return filed, need IRS form 4506-T)<br>Unemployment letter (if receiving Unemployment benefits)<br>Support letter:<br><div style="margin-left: 40px;">           *Letter indicating who is providing support for day-to-day living expenses.<br/>           *Can use MedAssist’s standard letter template, or create one         </div> |

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## **REGISTRATION**

New clients are interviewed by appointment. The following information is needed:

**\*You must have a primary care physician**

**\*Social Security number**

**\*New or escript prescriptions** from your primary care physician for each medication

## **MEDICATIONS**

*CONTROLLED DRUGS and CHEMOTHERAPY DRUGS are not available.*

Your medications will be picked up at Halsey Drug according to our formulary with them.

We are an enrollment site for NC MedAssist. This state pharmacy can mail you 90 day supply according to their formulary and your eligibility.

## **REFILLS OF MEDICATIONS**

Clients **MUST** bring their empty bottles back for refills, new prescription or information of a physician escript to the pharmacy. We do not keep records of what your prescription needs are at the CARES site. So you must bring your empty bottle or a written prescription before medication can be ordered. A pick up slip must accompany local medication programs which will be given to clients by staff.
